AGILE DEVELOPMENT AT DECTRIS Ltd.

DECTRIS develops and produces Hybrid Photon Counting X-ray detectors for scientific and industrial customers. The detectors are designed to determine deep molecular structures with an increasingly high level of precision. This constantly requires development of more advanced high-resolution detectors.

To keep up with our customers' growing requirements for the technology, DECTRIS constantly improves its products. However, innovations are difficult to plan in detail. The development process must be adaptable to the changing requirements and have a high level of agility. Unfortunately reality in development adds another level of complexity, as not all aspects of the development process are equally agile.

At DECTRIS, for example, while the agile method "SCRUM" is used in software development, the implementation of this method is not always possible in hardware development. It is therefore important to find the best agile approaches and methods for each aspect of the development process.
